## Lead Cards—Always Valuable

Subscription books such as *The Bible Story* or *Foods that Heal* are often displayed in medical offices and various public locations. A literature evangelist (LE) places display books in these spots and provides a supply of reply cards inside the book that offer more information to potential customers. Someone can take a lead card from a book display, fill in their contact information, and drop the business reply card in the mail. When we receive the cards here in Hagerstown, Juanita Stinchfield sorts and mails them to the appropriate conference to forward to the LE. Through these contacts the LE has the possibility of leaving some Christian literature in the home and/or offering Bible studies.



Most of the cards come through the mail in good shape, but sometimes cards get a little worn or dirty, and a few are even torn or mangled during the mailing and sorting process. Juanita is very excited when even the most mangled cards have enough readable information for the LE to make a contact. The

conference then sends them to the LE to follow up on that lead. This affirms that the Lord is protecting His work and that He will not let anything stop those who are searching from connecting with Him. Please pray for the LEs and for the lead cards they place, that the Lord will continue to guide and protect.
