As of the publishing of this *Typeline* we don’t have the final sales figure, but the estimate is around \$800. We’ll give you the exact figure in the next issue.

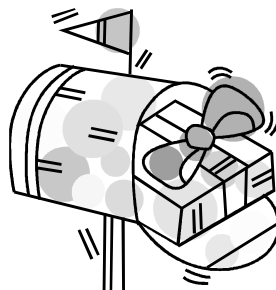

Donations Needed for W House

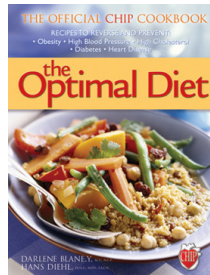

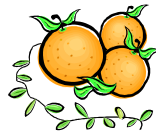
